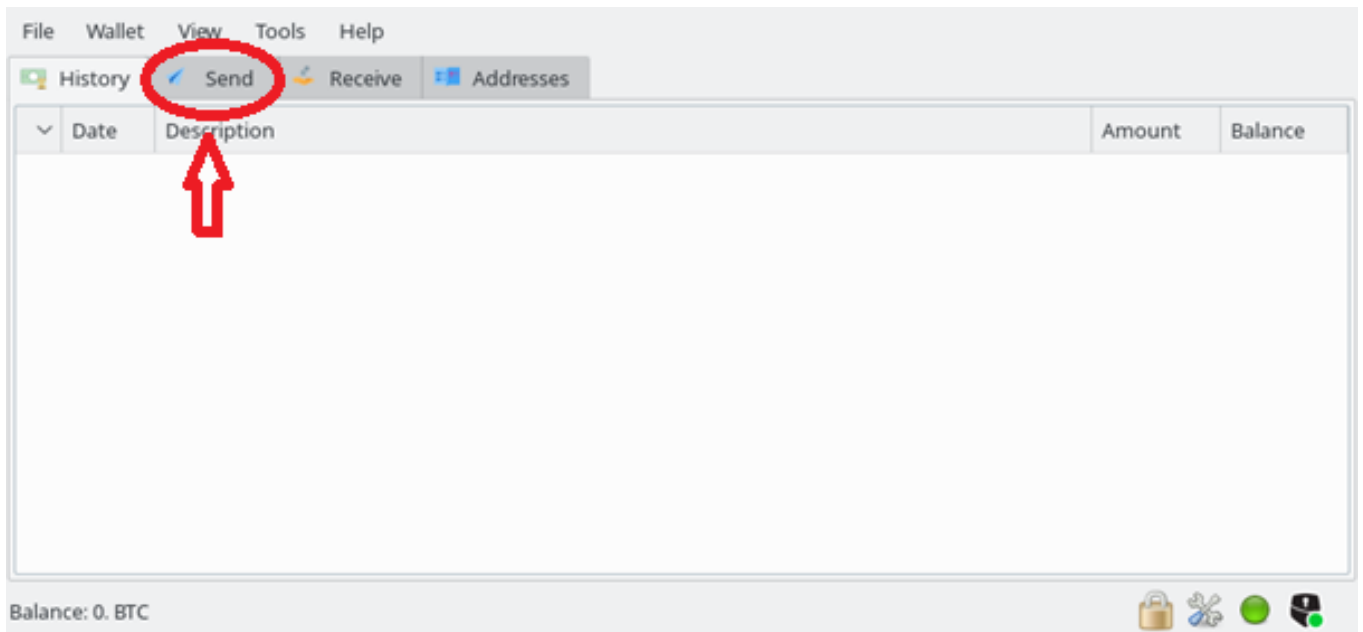


Bitcoins

Send bitcoins

To send bitcoins using elektrikum:

1. Click on send.

In the “Amount” box, enter the amount of bitcoins you want to send.

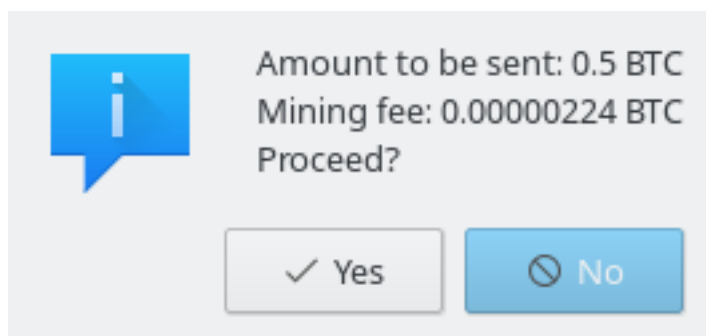
You’ll need to adjust the “fee” bar. The more fee you put, the quicker your transaction will be validated. We recommend leaving the “fee” bar in the middle.

When clicking on send, you’ll have to validate the transaction on your computer and **twice** on your Safe-T mini.

Make sure to check the information displayed on your Safe-T mini because that’s

By clicking on “History”, you have the history of your transactions displayed.

When green, it means that they are fully confirmed.
