Go to the All Apps section and open <u>Settings</u>. According to your Android `` version, open the Sound or Audio profile menu (and if necessary the setting icon besides the corresponding audio profile to open).

According to the available options, you will be able to modify:

- the default ringtone for the incoming calls
- the vibrate mode of the device in cas of incoming call
- the vibrate mode of the touchscreen keys
- the notification sound (messages, e-mails etc...)
- the ringtone, alarm & notification volume

Once you have finished, make sure to select the modified audio profile (if available) in order to apply your defined settings.
